Oscar Bears Day Care - Illness and injury policy

Aim

This policy aims to set out the procedure to be followed if a child becomes ill whilst in our care or suffers an injury whilst in our care.

We ask that parents do not send their child into nursery if they are obviously unwell. Children suffering with discharge from the eyes, sore throat or sickness and diarrhoea must be kept at home until at least 48 hours after they have last displayed the symptoms. Any child who is brought into nursery and obviously unwell will be sent home immediately.

Consent

If your child becomes unwell or is injured at Oscar Bears Day Care we will immediately attempt to contact you. If we are unable to contact you we will also try to contact all alternative numbers.

Upon registering at Oscar Bears Day Care you will be asked to sign a form allowing the manager to act on your behalf in an emergency situation.

Becoming ill whilst at Oscar Bears Day Care

If your child displays symptom of being unwell whilst at Oscar Bears staff will fully assess what is wrong and immediately attempt to contact the Childs parents.

Staff will asses if the child has a temperature or a rash as well as feeding back the other symptoms to the parent. A staff member will assigned to look after the child and ensure that they are as comfortable as possible until their parent is able to collect them from nursery.

If a parent has provided any medication and a medication form has signed medication may be given after seeking verbal advice from the parents.

If a child requires any urgent medical assistance the emergency services will be rung and medical intervention sought. Oscar Bears day care also reserves the right to seek any urgent medical advice for your child.

Injuries

If a child suffers any serious injury whilst at Oscar Bears Day Care parents will be informed immediately and medical advice/intervention sought.

Any accidents will be dealt with by a qualified staff member.

All injuries will be recorded on an accident form. Please see the policy on accident and incident reporting for further guidance.

Reporting



Oscar Bears Day Care has a responsibility to report any accident, injury, or serious illness to any children in our care to OFSTED and the local safeguarding children board.

Oscar Day Care also has a responsibility to report any notifiable disease to the local Health Protection Unit. We will also liase with the Health Protection Unit (if relevant) when ascertaining timescales of excluding children from nursery due to illness.
